Born in Nangchen, Tibet in the Karma Kagyu lineage, Khenpo Karten Rinpoche is trained in the Nyingma school of Tibetan Buddhism. He became the abbot of the Japa Monastery at age thirty. He is currently an emissary of His Holiness the Dalai Lama who has asked him to continue teaching throughout the world for the next two decades. His teaching centers are in Kathmandu, Nepal; Singapore, Malaysia-Ipoh; South India; Abington, MA; and Carmel, CA USA. Khenpo Karten Rinpoche is very enthusiastic and compassionate with a wonderful sense of humor.

This special teaching includes fundamental Buddhist topics including compassion, awareness, effort and ethics. It is designed for anyone, whether or not you practice Buddhism, and is presented in a manner that is accessible and user-friendly.
